Our Activities

- **Nehru Children's Museum** — a premier Tourist Centre in Kolkata for Children and Adults — visited by over 1.3 crores.
- **Vidyasagar Academy** – a centre for training in Drama, Dance, Singing, Science, Recitation and Painting.
- **'Sit & Draw Art Contest'**, organised every year. Nearly 2,000 children participate in the contest every year.
- **Financial aid** is given to **227 handicapped children** for continuing their studies and/or for vocational training @ 1800/- per year.
- **Jugal Srimal Scholarships** (Value of each Scholarship Rs. 1800/-) are given to Children in the streams of Rabindra Sangeet, Nazrul Geeti, Recitation (Bengali), Bharat Natyam, Kathak, Odissi.
- Workshops conducted in the field of Performing Arts by renowned artists throughout the year.
